Role Responsibility

FA License Coach First Aider

- Administer First Aid Treatment.
- Must have access to players medical details
 - Appoint Support persons 1 and 2
 - Contact Emergency Services
- Contact parent/guardian if not in attendance
- Inform Club Welfare Officer as soon as safe to do so.
 - Steve Wilson, Lead CWO
 - Katrina Williams, Junior CWO
 - Sally Lodo, Hereford Development Centre CWO

Role Responsibility

Nominated by Coach/First Aider at time of Incident

Emergency Services Liaison Support Person 1

- Stay with First Aider and casualty to communicate with Emergency Services and First Aider.
- Possible runner for Defibrillator & Support for acting First Aider.
- Open barrier and/or gates to allow emergency services on to site of incident
- Issue roles to other Support Persons

Must have mobile phone & MEAP for site information (MEAP located in Medical Bag)

Role Responsibility

Nominated by Support Person one if required Support Person 2

- Ensure entrance to Car Park and route to Playing area is clear of any parked cars.
- Unlock gate leading to Playing area and/or gate leading to grass pitches (depending on where incident is)
 - Stay at the Car Park Barrier/Gate.
 - Direct Emergency Vehicle to site of incident.

Must have mobile phone, Gate Key/Barrier Pass & MEAP.
